Apply for R&D assistance now

A reminder to any companies with a standard year of income from 1 July 2012 to 30 June 2013 and wishing to apply for the R&D Tax Incentive must lodge their registration application with AusIndustry by 30 April 2014.

The R&D Tax Incentive helps businesses offset some of the cost of doing R&D. The program aims to help more businesses to engage with the R&D process and to innovate.

The two core components are:

- a 45 per cent refundable tax offset (equivalent to a 150 per cent deduction) to eligible entities with an aggregated turnover of less than \$20 million per annum, and
- a non-refundable 40 per cent tax offset (equivalent to 133 per cent deduction) to all other eligible entities.
